




Welcome to the 24th year of CornerStone Dressage Shows. We are excited to welcome you back to the Caledon Pan Am Equestrian Park.

Please note that <u>all</u> competition rings and warm up rings will now be on the All Weather Euro footing.

Spring Into Dressage, Summer Festival and Summer Classic are National Gold Shows offering all levels of competition from Walk/Trot to Grand Prix.

FEI Young Rider and FEI Junior Divisions will be held in the CDI as well as in the Gold shows again this year.
Two judges will be on for the Gold Show as per NAJRYC requirements. July and August shows will have two judges.

A separate prize list is available for the Spring Into Dressage CDI Platinum show. We have added the Under 25 division and the 5 &6 year old Young Horse classes to the CDI 3*.

We will also be offering Bronze Classes from Walk-Trot to Fourth Level in conjunction with the Gold Classes. Championships in Bronze will not be awarded. See Page 13.

A full Prix St. Georges Amateur Division with PSG, Int 1 and Int1 Freestyle will be offered. Horses may show in this division as well as the Advanced Open Division. We will also offer a PSG Amateur class on Saturday and Sunday at each show.

If you have not paid for your entries in advance of the show, we require a signed, blank cheque to be left with the office before a number will be released. Please remember that we do not accept credit cards. Email transfer of funds is also an acceptable method of payment.

Fully completed Entry Forms with all membership numbers and all signatures and a current Coggins Test are required.

PERSON RESPONSIBLE

The person responsible for a horse is an adult who has, or shares, responsibility for the care, training, custody and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC rules. This person is liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violation of the EC Rules.

The Person Responsible must hold a valid EC Sport License in good standing at the same level or higher in which the horse is competing. However, when the competitor is a Junior, the competitor cannot be the Person Responsible and the Person Responsible may be a parent/guardian who must be at minimum an EC or USEF member in good standing. The entry form must list the Person Responsible's name, their EC or USEF member number and be signed.

General Regulations A1011 and Page 105

Statement of Principles

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction. All Persons shall be committed to: x upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities; x requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment; x ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose; x providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals 2016 Rules of Equine Canada Section A Page v and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure; x providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives; x continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare; x requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions; and x actively promoting the development of and adherence of to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane

Memberships

All competitors at a show with Gold Level sanctioning must have a Gold or Platinum Equine Canada Sport License Membership.

All riders in the Gold Show must have a Dressage Canada membership.

All riders entered in the Amateur divisions must have an EC Amateur membership

Competitors competing only in the Bronze classes require a Bronze license which can be purchased through the show office on arrival. Horses do not require a passport to compete at Bronze level.

Event Upgrade License is available for Bronze and Silver license holders to compete in Gold competition.

Cadora-Ontario Bronze Awards

To be eligible for annual Cadora-Ontario BRONZE awards, a competitor must:

be a Cadora-Ontario member by June 1st of the current year and compete in the same class/level in a minimum of three (3)
BRONZE competitions during the calendar year
(January 1st – December 31st).

1st and 2nd placings are awarded in each class level and category (Open/Amateur/Junior), Walk/Trot through Fourth Level including freestyles. Additional placings, up to a maximum of eight, are awarded based on the number of eligible competitors at each level. Five eligible competitors are required for each additional award. [An eligible competitor is a Cadora-Ontario member who has competed in a minimum of three Bronze competitions].

Award winners are decided by totaling the three highest scores received by each horse/rider combination from three different Bronze dressage competitions during the calendar year (January 1st to December 31st).

A minimum score of 55% of the possible total must be achieved for a competitor to be eligible to receive an award. Scores from Bronze competitors only (NOT Silver!) are to be sent to the BRONZE Coordinator immediately following your Bronze competitions. Scores at Walk/Trot and Training Levels can be obtained from tests ridden in either the 20x40 ring or the 20x60 ring.

Year-End Cadora-Ontario BRONZE award winners will be honoured at the Annual General Meeting of Cadora-Ontario.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: To be eligible for a Cadora-Ontario award (including the Cadora-Ontario Team Championships), you MUST be a member of Cadora-Ontario no later than June 1st of the current year.

CornerStone Horse Shows General Rules and Regulations

ENTRIES: Entries must be accompanied by a cheque if mailed.

Post dated cheques will not be accepted.

Entries must be received by the Secretary at 674541 Hurontario St. Mono, Ontario. L9W 5S1 by the closing date. Fax 519-941-8096 or email csfhorses@aol.com.

<u>Faxed</u>/Emailed entries without accompanying payment are subject to a \$10.00 service charge. The show does not take responsibility for faxed or emailed entries. Competitors should check our website for received entries.

<u>Incomplete entries</u> will be charged an additional \$10.00.

FEES: A signed, open cheque for entries not paid in advance must be left with the office before a number is released. We do not accept credit cards. Email transfer of funds is accepted.

CornerStone reserves the right to request guaranteed funds <u>in advance</u> from customers with a history of late or non negotiable payments. Outstanding accounts from previous shows will be settled first before any monies submitted are credited to the current show account.

Please make cheques payable to CornerStone. Any cheque returned by the bank for any reason will be charged a \$50.00 fee.

<u>CANCELLATION POLICY:</u> Refunds of 100% of entry and stabling fees, less the administration fee will be made prior to the closing date of entries. Refunds of 50% of class entry fees, drug & levy will be made after the closing date and before the start of the show.

There will be NO refunds on stabling fees after the closing date. Scratches after the show starts will lose the total entry/stabling fees. Drug & Levy to be refunded.

Veterinary or doctor certificates are not required for any scratches.

LATE ENTRIES/SUBSTITUTIONS: will be accepted at the discretion of the show management subject to space availability in classes and a late fee of \$50.00.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: There will be a fee of \$40.00 per day charged for any non-showing horse. Non-showing horses must complete an entry form including signing the waiver. They must wear a number while in the schooling and exercise areas. Administration fees and paramedic fees will be applied.

HORS CONCOURS: Competitors will be accepted at the discretion of the organizing committee if space is available. See Rule E.7.11.11

PRIZE MONEY: Monies will only be paid in classes with 6 or more entries.

<u>PASSPORTS:</u> GOLD ONLY All competitors must present a valid EC or FEI passport for the horse being exhibited including a 2016 EC horse license sticker before receiving the number. Passports will be returned upon complete payment of account. Affidavit for Foreign owned horses is required for horses without a valid EC or FEI Passport.

Temporary Horse Registration may be purchased at the show.

NUMBERS: If the account has not been paid in advance, an open signed cheque must be left with the Show Office in order to pick up the number. Competitor numbers must be worn at all times when the horse is outside the stall. E.7.11.2

RIDING TIMES: Riding times will be available at www.cornerstone farms.com the weekend before each show.

SHOW STABLING: The cost per stall used is \$185.00 for the duration of the show. Day stalls are not available.

Stalls will be available from 7 a.m. Thursday.

Gold show horses will <u>not</u> be allowed to stable in the FEI Stabling barns. Shavings and hay are available for purchase upon arrival. Pre orders will be accepted. Orders for same day delivery must be received in the office by 11 a.m. Please bathe horses in wash rack areas only.

Barns or Individuals who wish to be stabled together should fill out <u>one</u> form listing all the horses and required tack stalls. This should avoid the problem of duplicate stall bookings or competitors not being stabled with the barn of their choice.

<u>Please note:</u> If you have a stallion or a horse that does not like his neighbours please bring your own boards for extending the wall partitions. The show will endeavour to accommodate your special requests but will not guarantee it.

EXERCISE/SCHOOLING SCHEDULE: Competition rings will be available for schooling on Thursday ONLY from 9 am until dark. Competition rings are closed to schooling on competition days.

ASTM/SE OR BSI/BS EN APPROVED HELMETS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL MOUNTED RIDERS ON THE SHOW-GROUNDS AT ALL TIMES.

RING SIZES: All classes will be run in 20m x 60m rings. (Exception. Para as required)

<u>TESTS:</u> Dressage Tests will be the current EC and FEI Tests. Walk-Trot Tests will be Equine Canada Tests.

Tests may be downloaded from www.dressagecanada.ca.

CAMPER SITES:

Camper sites are available at \$175.00 per site per show.

Water and electrical hookups are provided. Pump outs are available at an extra charge in cash and must be booked in the office. Camping on the show grounds with or without hookups is not permitted without paying for a camper site. There is absolutely no grey water drainage allowed on the grounds.

Showers not available.

CAMPER SPACE MUST BE RESERVED IN WRITING ON THE CAMPER REQUEST FORM FOUND ON THE WEBSITE.

INSURANCE: All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They therefore must take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and keep the policy up to date.

PARKING: Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. There is no parking on the roads or in the barn areas at any time. After unloading, please move your vehicles from the stabling area to the parking areas.

<u>DOGS:</u> All dogs must be on a max. 6 foot lead at all times. There is a \$100.00 fine for loose dogs. Remember to clean up after your dog.

QUERIES: Questions concerning rules, scoring or entries must be made to the Steward for discussion with the Organizing Committee. Protests must be made in writing within 48 hours of the completion of the class and accompanied by a

deposit of \$100.00, cash or certified cheque. See EC General Regulations Chapter 12. The show grounds may be monitored at any time of the day or night by the stewards.

CLASS LIMITATIONS: Corner Stone reserves the right to limit entries, divide or combine classes and govern all conditions of the competitions. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

Please note: If there are fewer than 6 entries in any offered classes,
Management reserves the right to combine classes that are scheduled as split (ie: Open, Junior, Amateur) within the same level. No prize money will be Awarded in classes with fewer than 6 entries.

WHIPS: Whips may be carried in most National Classes. See EC Rules E.4.8

DRUG TESTING: Any horse, entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location. Drug fees are applicable per horse. (Bronze \$3.50, Gold \$7.00)

<u>ADULT AMATEUR DIVISION:</u> An Adult Amateur Division will be held in some levels. Adult Amateur entrants may also enter the Open Classes. Amateurs must hold a current EC Amateur Card.

JUNIOR/PONY DIVISIONS: A Junior/Pony Division will be held in some levels. Juniors may also enter the Open Classes. Junior riders as defined by EC are those who have not reached their 18th birthday as of January 1, 2016.

FEI PONY DIVISION: Riders may show in this division from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the year they turn 16.

Stewards will be available measure ponies upon request. Only those without a measurement need to be done.

FREESTYLE CLASSES: We strongly recommend competitors provide two copies of their music in case of technical difficulties. A sound check with the announcer may be arranged.

Eligibility—55% in a technical test at the same level.

EVENT PARAMEDICS: Paramedics will be on site each Competition day.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: All motorized vehicles including golf carts, scooters, dirt bikes etc. must be operated by a licensed driver only.

SECURITY: Security will not be provided on the show grounds. CornerStone will not accept responsibility for items lost or damaged on the show grounds. Competitors are advised not to leave possessions, including tack unattended at any time.

TACK CHECK: Under EC rules it is the Rider's responsibility to report to the ring Steward immediately after their test, without dismounting, for a tack check. Tack checks are not required before the test but an unofficial check may be done as a courtesy by the Steward. Failure to report to the Steward will result in elimination.

PRESENTATIONS: Ribbons and trophies may be picked up from the Results Table in the Pavilion as soon as the official results are posted. For the convenience of exhibitors, there will be no mounted or formal presentations unless there is a sponsor for the class. In which case, presentations may be mounted. Competitors will be advised in advance.

"Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition."
